CHAIRMAN ADDRESS TO 16[™] ACADEMIC COUNCIL FOR 2020-21

21st Aug. 2021

I welcome all esteem members of this 16th Academic Council for 2020-21. Initially, I express my regret for too much delay in conducting this meeting for the Academic Session:2020-21. Very soon we will have Academic Council for Coming Session: 2021-22. But, as you are all aware of, the Covid-19 has disrupted and caused serious harms to the academic world by posing threats to life. But education cannot stop, though its pace has been slowed down and delayed. Given the necessity of updating syllabi from time to time for a close links between the classrooms and the larger world, the Annual Meeting of the Academic Council is very important, hence unavoidable. This provides a forum for discussion of important academic activities for maintaining required academic standard.

Soon after assuming the power of Principal with effect from 01-7-2020, I have devoted most of my efforts to achieve the following things:

- 1. Scheduling of classes with allotment of rooms and time to avoid any disruption of classes
- 2. Re-structing the functioning of Examination Section
- 3. Creating a physical attractive ambience of academic centre and
- 4. Overall improvement of academic standard

I will not say this has been a smooth sailing. Given the fact that we are slave to past ideas and customary way of working, there have been oppositions to the achievement of these objectives. But I am more than satisfied that achievement has been what I wanted to do.

I will only highlight the following achievements:

- 1. Physical Security of the Campus has been enhanced by blocking all unnecessary passages. A separate entrance has been created for smooth entry and exit of HS students and their vehicles.
- 2. The re-location of the congested Examination Section prior to 01-7-2020 to New Building with a lot of space for work and meeting. This is an achievement of most urgency and was pursued for some years when I was Controller of Examinations.
- 3. The much clumsy payments mechanism for examination related expenditures has been re-structured to facilitate payments though banking system as much as possible.
- 4. The publication of Final Degree results under Ad Hoc Examination Regulation for 2019
- 5. Conduct of Online examinations with innovative ways, which is still underway
- 6. Last but not the least the creation of a green face of the College, an overdue thing.

There have been significant failures, particularly, on the following areas:


- 1. The efforts for examination automation as desired was not facilitated by the Government. This work has to be pursued in future.
- 2. There has been no progress at all in the matters of renewal of NAAC accreditation. Much hard work has to be put in here
- 3. A lot of progress in examination section has been halted because of unavoidable changes in the manning of examination section
- 4. Conduct of Practical Examinations has been a major concern without any visible solution

I hope esteem members understand the critical issues of NAAC accreditation. Any failure on this front will put an end to the survival of this Council and desire to contribute to educational needs of this locality. Let there be some time spent on his matter of urgency besides carrying out the usual task of approving the various academic resolutions.

I am thankful to all of you for being here to address the calls of improving the educational necessity of this locality. I only hope, we continue to meet in future also. Thank you.
