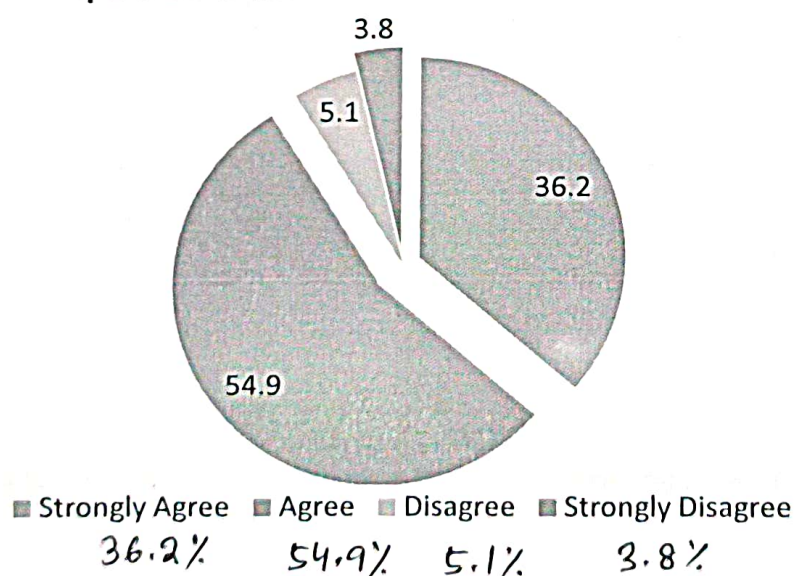

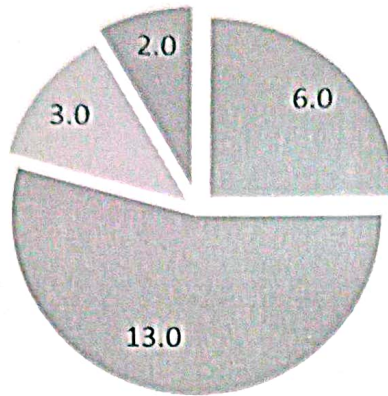

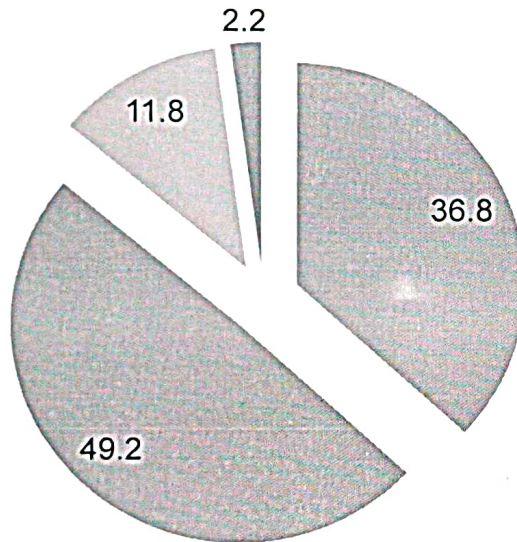
Percentage Opinion on the syllabus was updated to meet the demand of students



Getting enough time to cover the syllabus?

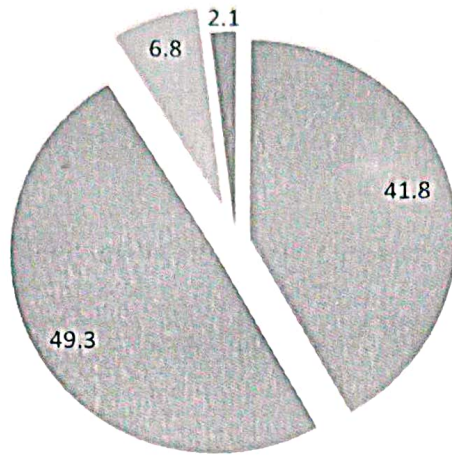

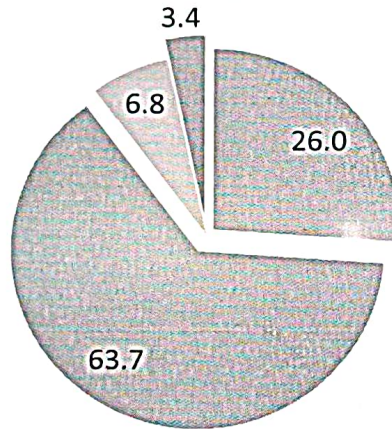

Does your syllabus create interest to pursue higher studies/employability?



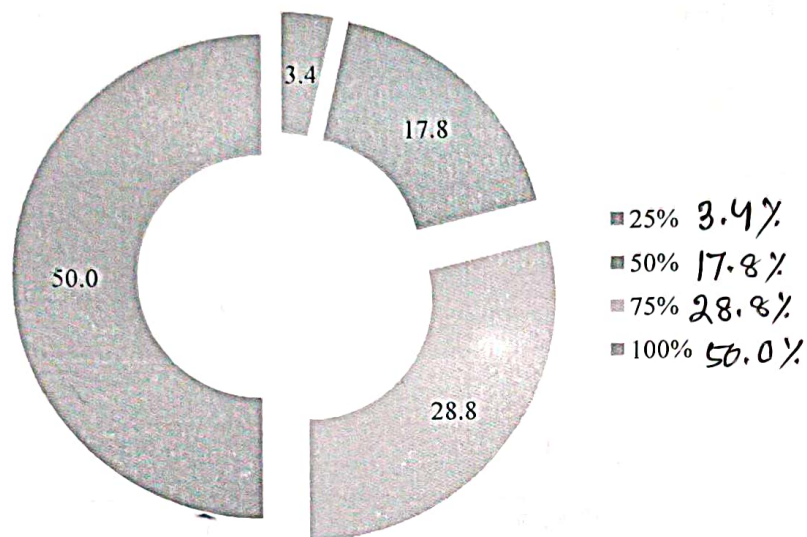

Does the Assessment pattern measure your complete knowledge?

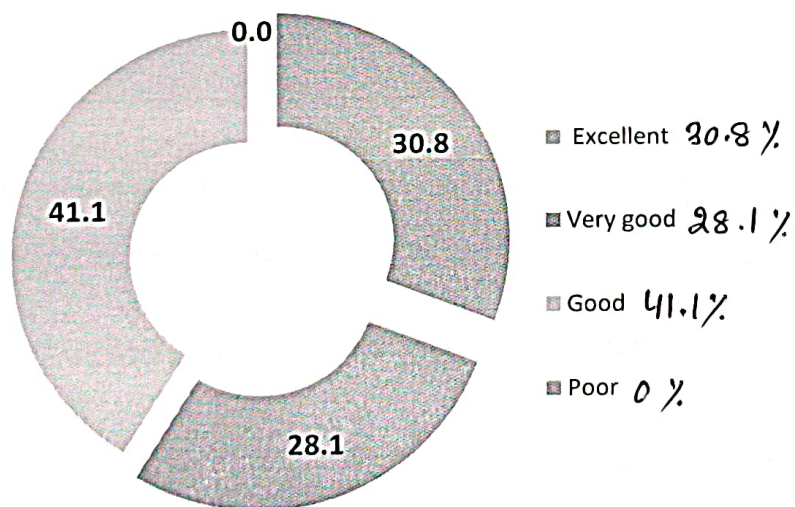

evaluation process?**



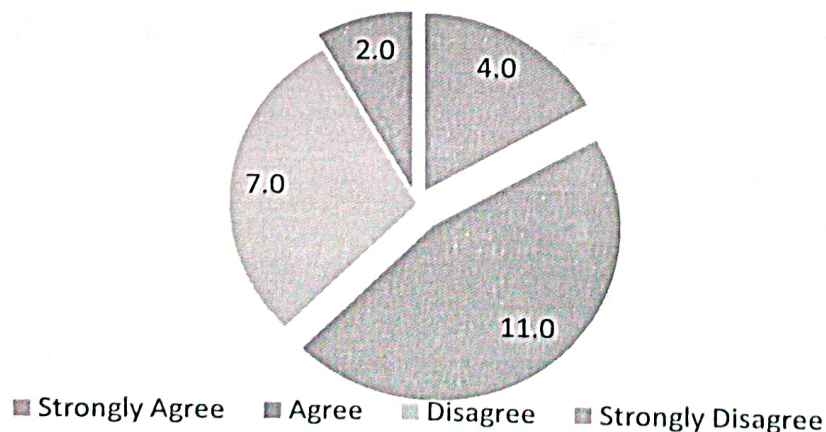

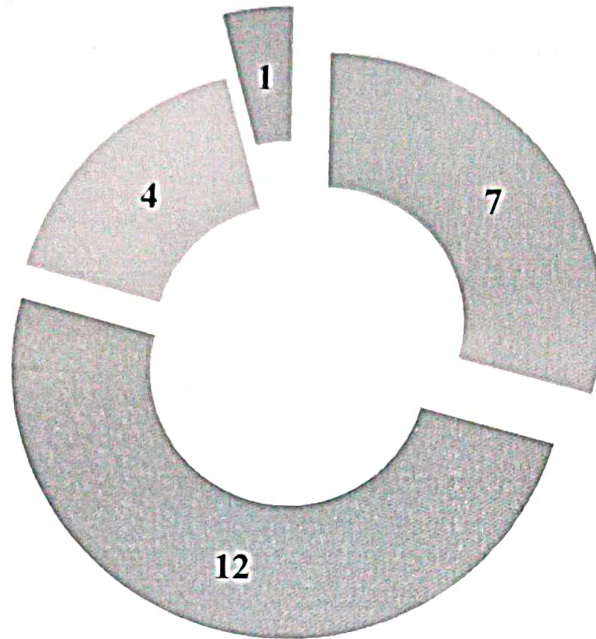

Percentage Opinion on was the syllabus updated to meet the demand of students?

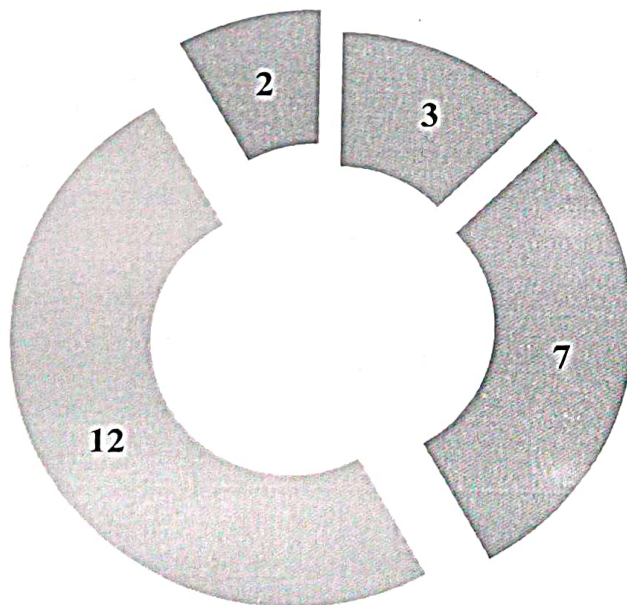


Your opinion about continuous evaluation process?



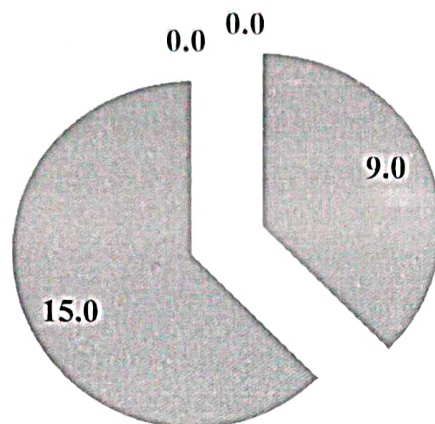

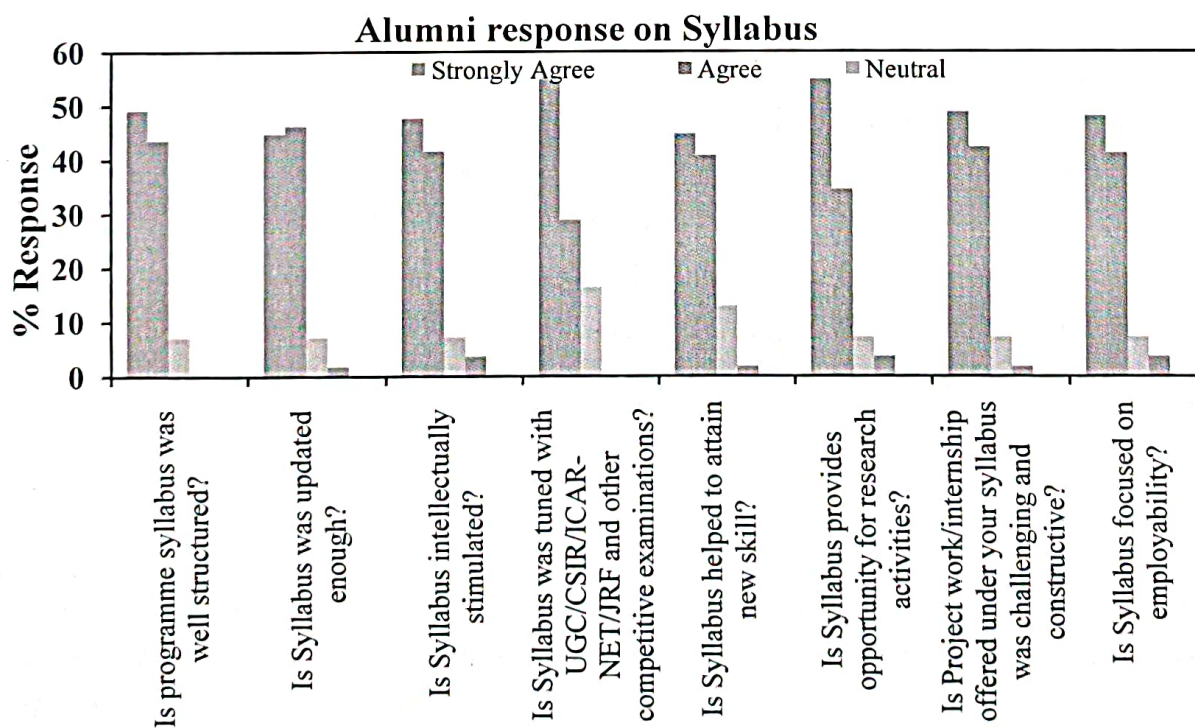

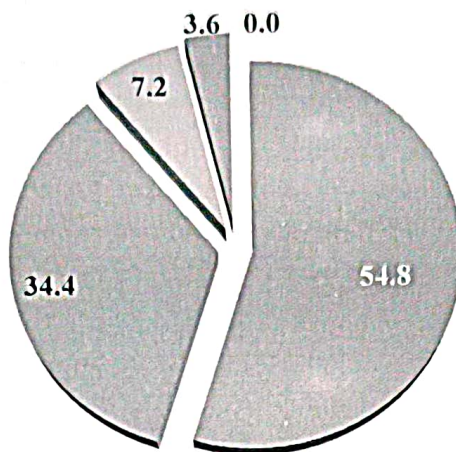

Analysis of feedback in terms of % response (The values are rounded up to one decimal point)



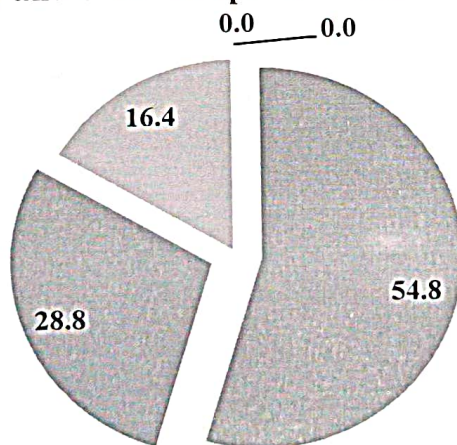
Does the Syllabus provide opportunity for research activities?

54.8% of the respondents were strongly agreed that the Syllabus provides opportunities for research activities while 34.4% and 7.2% of the respondents were agreed and neutral to it respectively. 3.6% of the respondents have opined it as disagree and none strongly disagree respectively.

OBSERVATIONS:

The following are the observations made from the feedback given

- Most of the Alumni given their positive consent on existing syllabus and curriculum that are intellectually stimulating and updated enough as per recent development.
- The Curriculum requires opportunities for research activities which was highly recommended by the esteemed members of the Alumni.
- The silence regarding syllabus that tuned with NET examinations emphasizes the syllabus revision in the future.

Action Taken Report:

- College developed a mechanism to design and timely updation of curriculum by certified experts committee/Boards of the studies.
- Keeping the suggestions or recommendations of the Alumni a few changes have been introduced in Academic session in 2023-24 and ratified in the Academic Council.
- College introduced Skill Enhancement Courses in the curriculum to improve the practical exposure on different aspects.

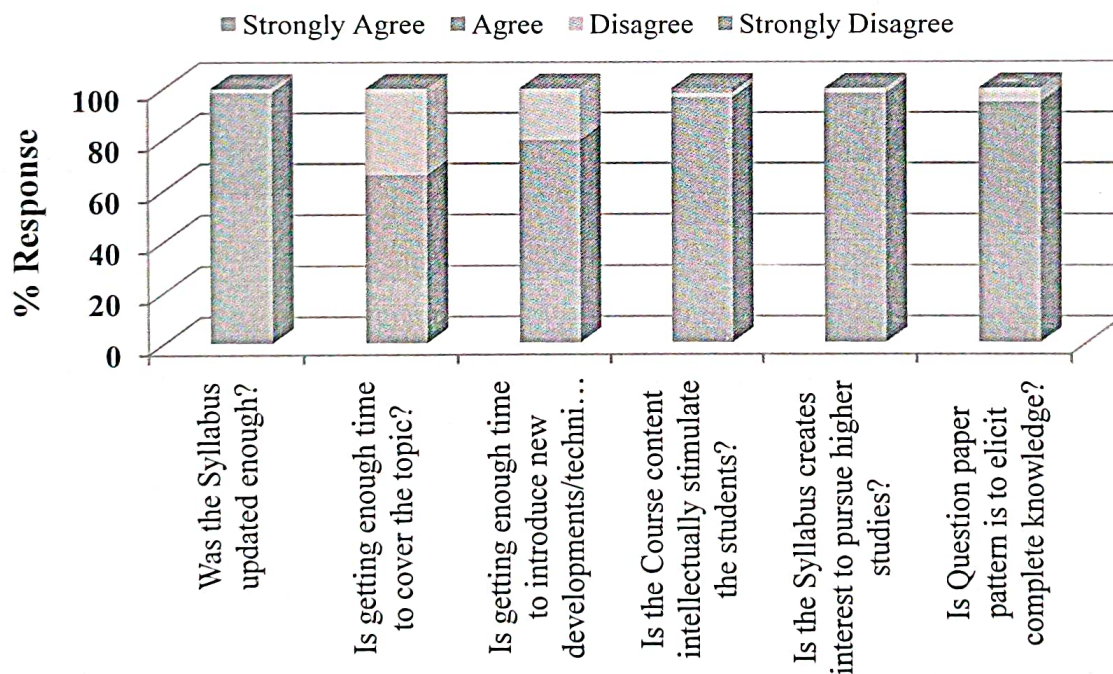

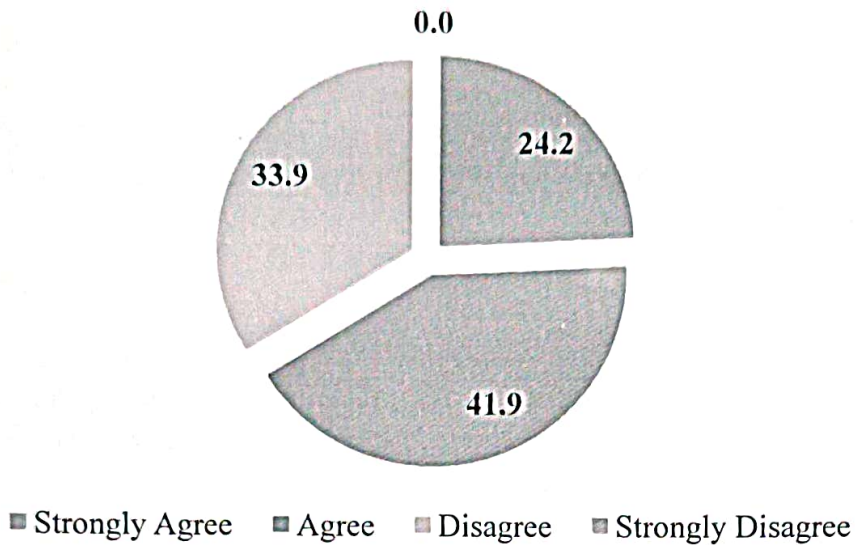

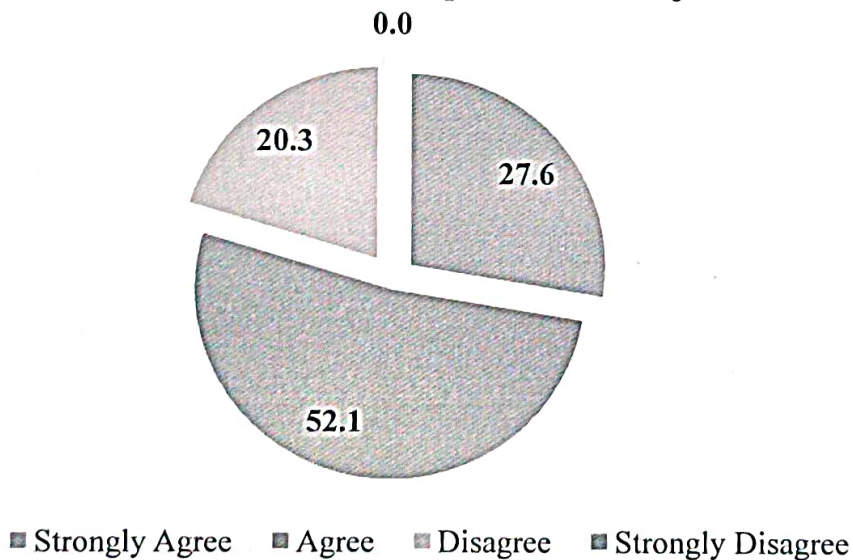


Is getting enough time to cover the topic?



24.2% of the respondents were strongly agreed on whether they were getting enough time to cover the topic while 41.9% of the respondents were agreed to it. Interestingly, 33.9% of the respondents have opined it as disagree that the time was not enough to cover a topic in the prescribed syllabus.

Is getting enough time to introduce new developments/techniques in the subject?



27.6% of the respondents were strongly agreed on whether they were getting enough time to introduce new developments in the subject while 52.1% of the respondents were agreed to it. Interestingly, 20.3% of the respondents have opined it as disagree that the time was not enough to introduce new cutting-edge technology in a topic in the prescribed syllabus.

OBSERVATIONS:

The following are the observations made from the feedback given


- Teachers are satisfied with course content and curriculum, helpful for both Placements and Higher Education.
- Up-gradation of Curriculum as per NEP 2020 is highly recommended.
- ILMS and e-contents can be made available to the students for efficient learning.
- Apart from theory courses, skill oriented courses/workshops can be introduced.

Action Taken Report:

- Appointment of regular faculties is badly needed as significant response disagreed to the question that getting enough time to cover the topic.
- Feedback analysed and changes made in the syllabus.
- In this regard, state government has initiated the recruitment process.
- It was also recommended that the College should introduce Entrepreneurship/Employability/Skill development oriented Courses in the curriculum to improve the novel techniques or methodology in the concerned subject.



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
